- ❖ **Why do exposures continue? What do the rules require? What are the costs of compliance versus noncompliance?** "EPA banned all new uses for asbestos in 1989. OSHA initiated regulations addressing asbestos exposures in general industry and construction in 1986. Efforts are underway to ban the use of asbestos globally entirely following reports by the International Trade Union Confederation (ITUC) that asbestos claims one life every five minutes around the clock and costs billions of dollars in compensation costs. Despite these regulations, workers today still suffer from asbestos exposure in occupations that use products made of asbestos.
