Enclosed is the final 2006 Community Support Program (CSP) report. It consists of a summary of the data, as well as several spreadsheet tables which highlight key aspects of the information supplied by the certified CSPs around the state. We appreciate the cooperation of all 80 programs around the state, as well as the promptness shown by most programs in filling out the electronic survey. We rely on these data to report to the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration as part of our application for block grant funds, and we need key pieces of information to make decisions on budget initiatives that further improve our services and supports for people with mental illness. The spreadsheets enclosed are the client counts for each program between 2002 and 2006, the number of enrollees discharged from the program and enrolled into other programs, and information on CSP waiting lists

We are concerned that most of the programs around the state show significant discrepancies between the self-reported numbers in this report and the numbers that we obtain from the Human Services Reporting System (HSRS) database when we run reports of client counts for the same date, in this case December 31, 2006. While we did not highlight these discrepancies in this year's report, we are interested in resolving them. Please check your self-reported numbers against the HSRS reports you routinely receive and correct any problems you may see.
