


## SAP-SIS Update – December 15, 2010

**In order to help funders identify how prevention dollars are being spent, an update is being made to the SAP-SIS reporting system. This change will not affect records that have been submitted and approved. It will affect all submissions after December 15, 2010.**

Since SAP-SIS went live May, 2008 we have been reviewing feedback from users and from federal funders. After reviewing SAP-SIS submissions for three years, it has become apparent that the title of the intervention does not provide sufficient description as to the substance or nature of the prevention program being implemented. We need additional description on the programs that users are reporting in SAP-SIS. This update is to inform you about a new SAP-SIS data requirement that will begin December 15, 2010.

On December 15, 2010, all new SAP-SIS submissions will need to include a brief description of the primary prevention program that is being reported. We are looking for any additional information about your activities that will help us better understand how primary prevention dollars are being spent in Wisconsin. The description may include intended program outcomes or reasoning behind selecting the program for implementation. Users will need to provide a brief description of their program in 250 characters or less.
