

GAINING THE RIGHT AMOUNT OF WEIGHT

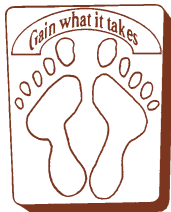
Gaining enough weight is important for all pregnant women, to grow a healthy baby.

How Much Weight Should You Gain?

There is a weight gain goal that is good for you and your baby. Here are some weight gain ranges to help find your weight gain goal:

- 28 to 40 pounds for underweight women
- 25 to 35 pounds for normal weight women
- 15 to 25 pounds for overweight women

Very overweight women and women carrying twins or triplets need special weight gain ranges.



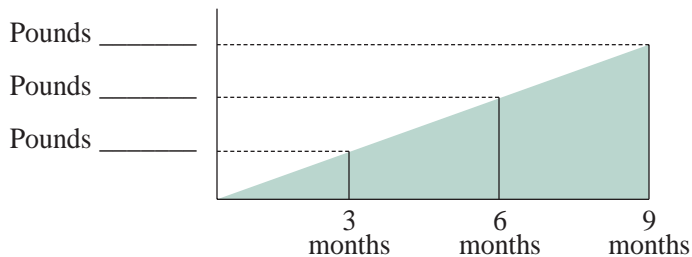

When Should You Gain Weight?

Most women should gain weight throughout the pregnancy. After your third month of pregnancy you should gain about _____ pounds each month.

What you need to weigh at:



Not many women like to gain weight! But pregnancy is different. Weight gain is natural.

If you are gaining less weight than you should . . .

✓ Eat foods high in calories and nutrients.

Good Foods for you, include these:

- Milk
- Peanut butter
- Hamburgers
- Dry fruit
- Cheese
- Pizza
- Milkshakes
- Nuts
- Beans and rice
- Ice cream
- Meat, fish, chicken
- Creamed foods

✓ Eat 4 to 6 times a day.

✓ If you are smoking, quit or cut way back.

✓ Rest when you can, try to get at least 8 hours of sleep.

If you are gaining more weight than you should . . .

✓ Drink low fat or fat free milk. Fat free milk has fewer calories.

✓ Eat fruits and vegetables for snacks.

✓ Eat less fried foods and other foods high in fat.

✓ Walking is a simple exercise almost everyone can do. Find 20 minutes a day to walk, unless your doctor says not to.

✓ Drink water when you are thirsty.
