BadgerCare Plus Ensures That All Children Have Access To Health Care

BadgerCare Plus can provide health care coverage to:

- ALL children (birth to age 19) regardless of income
- Pregnant women with family income up to 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) (see chart below)
- Parents and relatives who care for a child with family income up to 200% of the FPL
- Parents whose children are in foster care with family income up to 200% of the FPL
- Farmers and other self-employed parents with family income up to 200% of the FPL
- Young adults (ages 18 through 20) who are leaving foster care and turn age 18 on or after 01/01/08, regardless of income

*2011 Monthly Family Income Levels

Group Size	200% FPL	300% FPL
1	\$1,815.00	\$2,722.50
2	\$2,451.67	\$3,677.50
3	\$3,088.33	\$4,632.50
4	\$3,725.00	\$5,587.50

For each additional person, add:		
	\$636.67	\$955

*These amounts are based on the 2011 Federal Poverty Level income guidelines, which may increase by a small percentage each year.

Covered Services

Depending on which plan you are in, BadgerCare Plus may pay for:

- ➔ Preventive services such as doctor visits, prenatal care, check ups and immunizations (shots)
- ➔ Vision care
- ➔ Prescription drugs
- ➔ Family planning services and supplies
- ➔ Speech, physical and occupational therapy
- ➔ Mental health services
- ➔ Medical equipment
- ➔ Hospital care
- ➔ Hearing services (including hearing aids)
- ➔ Lab and x-ray services

Out-of-Pocket Cost

BadgerCare Plus has two major health care plans. There are several limited plans which cover different services, each with different income limits.

The plan you're enrolled in depends on your family's income. Some plans will have spend-downs (deductibles), copayments and premiums.

You may not have to pay at all, but if you do, the amount you pay depends on your family income. You can be sure it's a good investment in your family's health.
