REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Tribes must comply with the DHFS Financial Management Manual for Tribes, Counties and 51 Boards. The Department's allowable cost policies will apply.

The purpose of this allocation is to provide early intervention and detection of pregnancy (EIDP) services, according to the new and revised 2006 DPH-Program Quality Criteria, to the population served by the tribal health clinic.

EIDP goals include, as stated in the DPH-Program Quality Criteria, include:

- Early detection of pregnancy and pregnancy-related risks;
- Timely intervention and continuity of care appropriate for patient pregnancy status and pregnancy plans (including pregnancy and contraceptive services);,; and
- Access to Medicaid programs (including Healthy Start and the Family Planning Waiver).

EIDP services are intended for women at risk of an unintended pregnancy or who suspect they could become (or could have become) pregnant. Among women who suspect they are at risk of an unintended pregnancy (within the past 72 hours), emergency contraception must be available, i.e., present and ready for use, as an early intervention.

Documentation (evidence of the deliverable) will consist of information in the GAC objective accomplishment notes indicating the number of unduplicated women receiving EIDP services. Assurances will be provided in the GAC negotiation screens that services will comply with all DPH Program Quality Criteria.
