The federal Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act, Public Law (P.L.) 109-248, was signed into law on July 27, 2006, and became effective on October 1, 2006. Effective January 1, 2008 a provision of the law required state agencies and their local governmental agencies or covered private agencies, to check all fingerprints of prospective foster and prospective adoptive parents. The fingerprints that are collected under this Act must be submitted to the Wisconsin Department of Justice and must be identified as submitted in compliance with the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act. The Wisconsin Department of Justice will process the fingerprints through the Wisconsin criminal information database and submit the fingerprints to the FBI for processing through the appropriate national criminal information databases.
