To improve asthma diagnosis and management.

Learning objectives

1. Diagnose asthma early and accurately.
2. Classify asthma severity at initial encounter and asthma control at every medical encounter.
3. Use spirometry to objectively assess pulmonary function.
4. Prescribe daily controller medications in a written asthma action plan for patients with persistent asthma.
5. Counsel families in environmental trigger control including smoke-free homes and mitigation of common indoor allergens.
