

# HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES EMERGENCY EVENTS SURVEILLANCE (HSEES)

## FIFTEEN-YEAR PERIOD: JANUARY 1, 1993 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2007

### TOTAL WISCONSIN EVENTS

The number of events meeting the surveillance definition of the Hazardous Substances Emergency Events Surveillance System during this 15-year period totaled **6,165**.

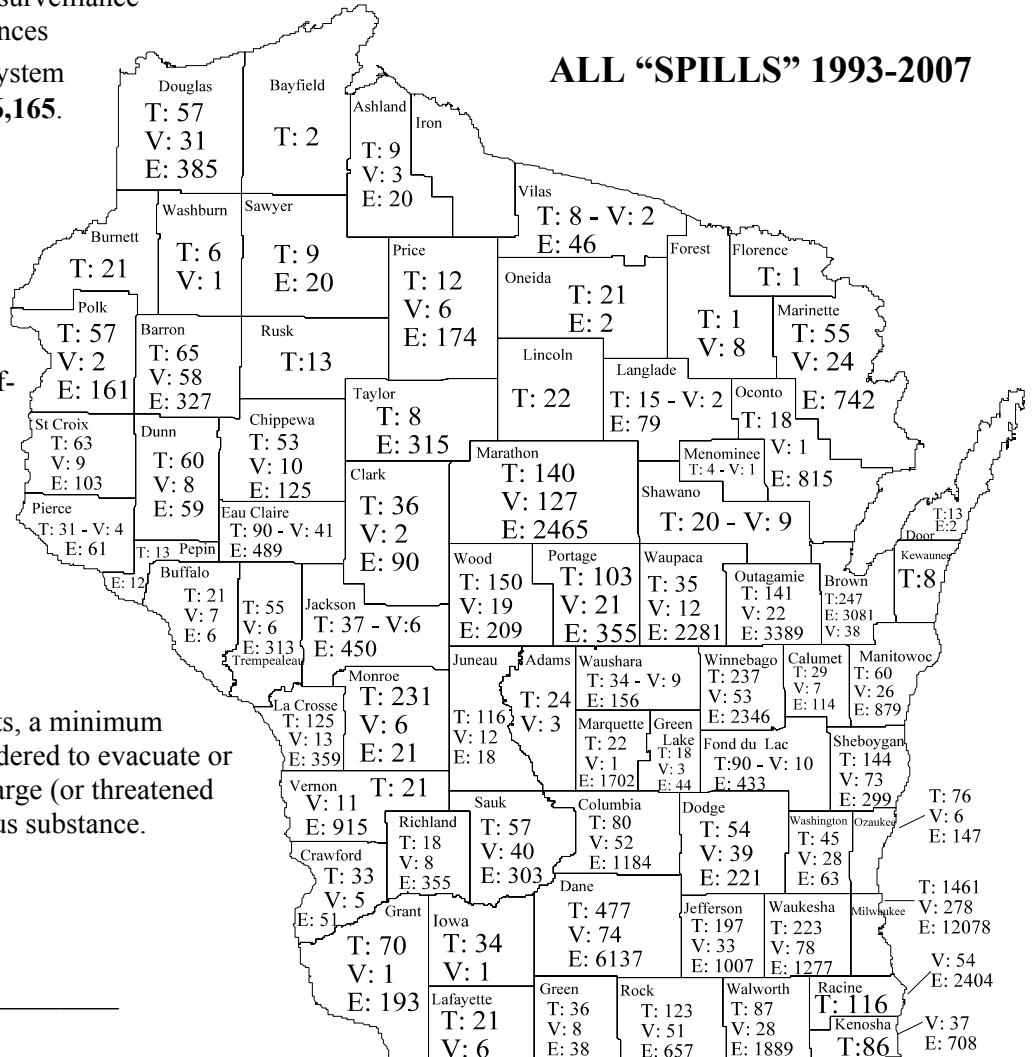
### EVENTS WITH VICTIMS

Of the 6,165 total events, **431** events resulted in a total of **1,529** victims, with each person suffering at least one verifiable injury resulting from exposure to a hazardous substance.

### EVENTS WITH EVACUEES\*

During **652** of the 6,165 total events, a minimum total of **52,575** individuals were ordered to evacuate or self-evacuated following the discharge (or threatened discharge) of one or more hazardous substance.
