▶ Check My Benefits

Check My Benefits is a free, easy-to-use tool on the ACCESS web site that lets you get up-to-date information about your FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus (including family planning services), SeniorCare and Caretaker Supplement benefits.

You can use **Check My Benefits** to find out which benefits you are getting, the date of your next review, why your benefits have changed, and whether your worker is waiting for information from you.

You will need to set up a secure account. To set up an account, go to access.wi.gov and follow the instructions on the screen. You will need the following information to create an account:

- Your name.
- Your Social Security Number (SSN) and date of birth. If you do not have an SSN, ask your worker for your Personal Identification Number (PIN).
- Either your *ForwardHealth* card, QUEST card or case number.

Once you have created an account, you can log in any time to check your benefits.

How to Use ACCESS in 3 Easy Steps!

- 1 Open a web browser and go to access.wi.gov
- 2 Click on the **Check My Benefits** button to check the status of your benefits.



Keep in mind that you will only see information about your FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus, SeniorCare and/or Caretaker Supplement benefits.

- 3 Follow the instructions on the screen. Keep in mind that all of your information will stay private and secure.

You can use ACCESS on any home computer with internet access. You may also be able to use a computer at your local job center, community service agency, church or library.

ACCESS will also help you:

- Apply online for FoodShare, Medicaid, BadgerCare Plus including Family Planning Services.
- Find out which low or no-cost health, nutrition and other programs you might be eligible for.
- Report changes online.
