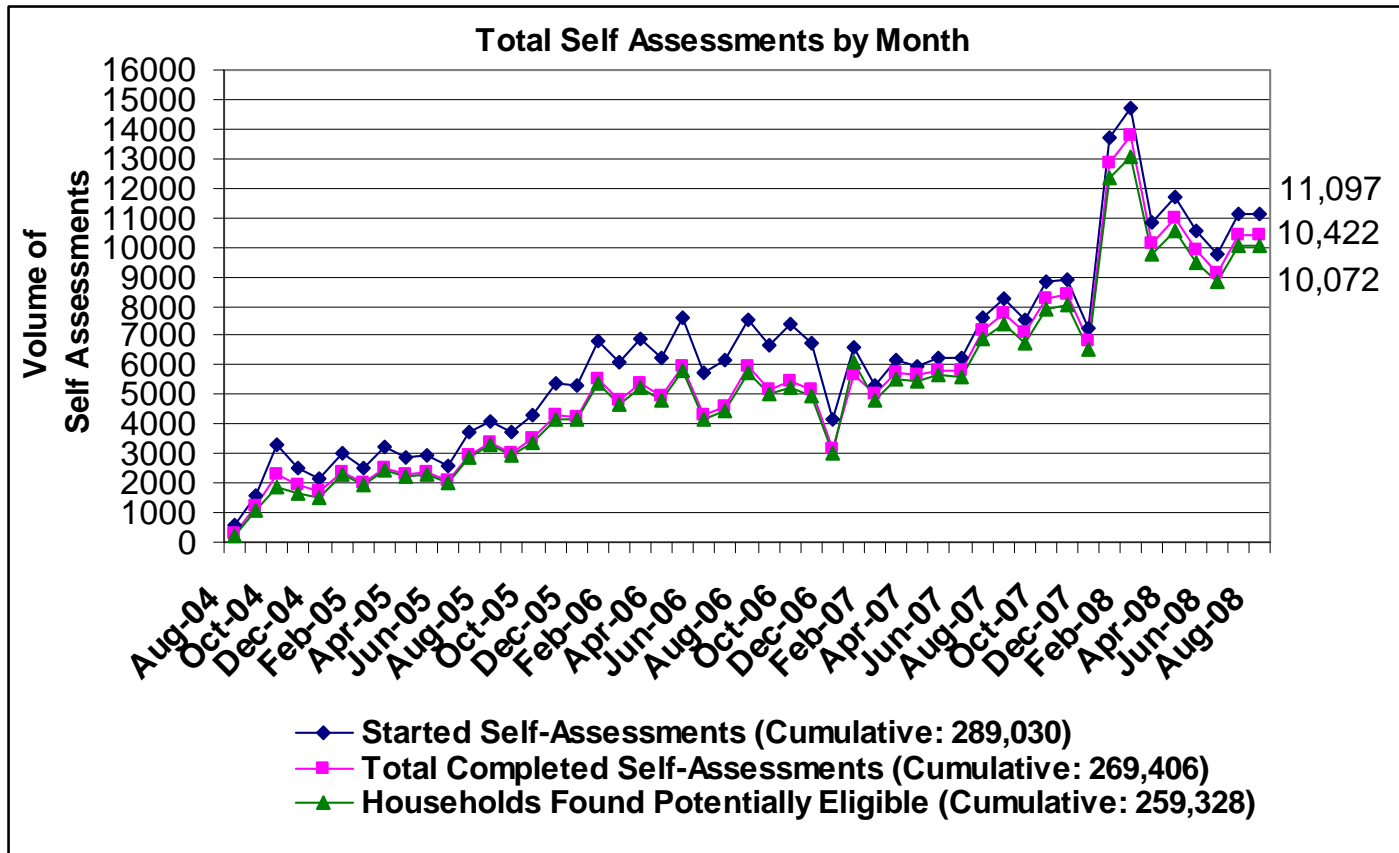




# **Am I Eligible? (AIE)**

# AIE Self Assessment Statistics



Average self assessments started per month: **10,652**

Average self assessments completed per month: **9,989**

On average, it took between **15 to 20** minutes to complete a self assessment

-August 2004 through November 2004 totals include the Family Medicaid and FoodShare Programs only.

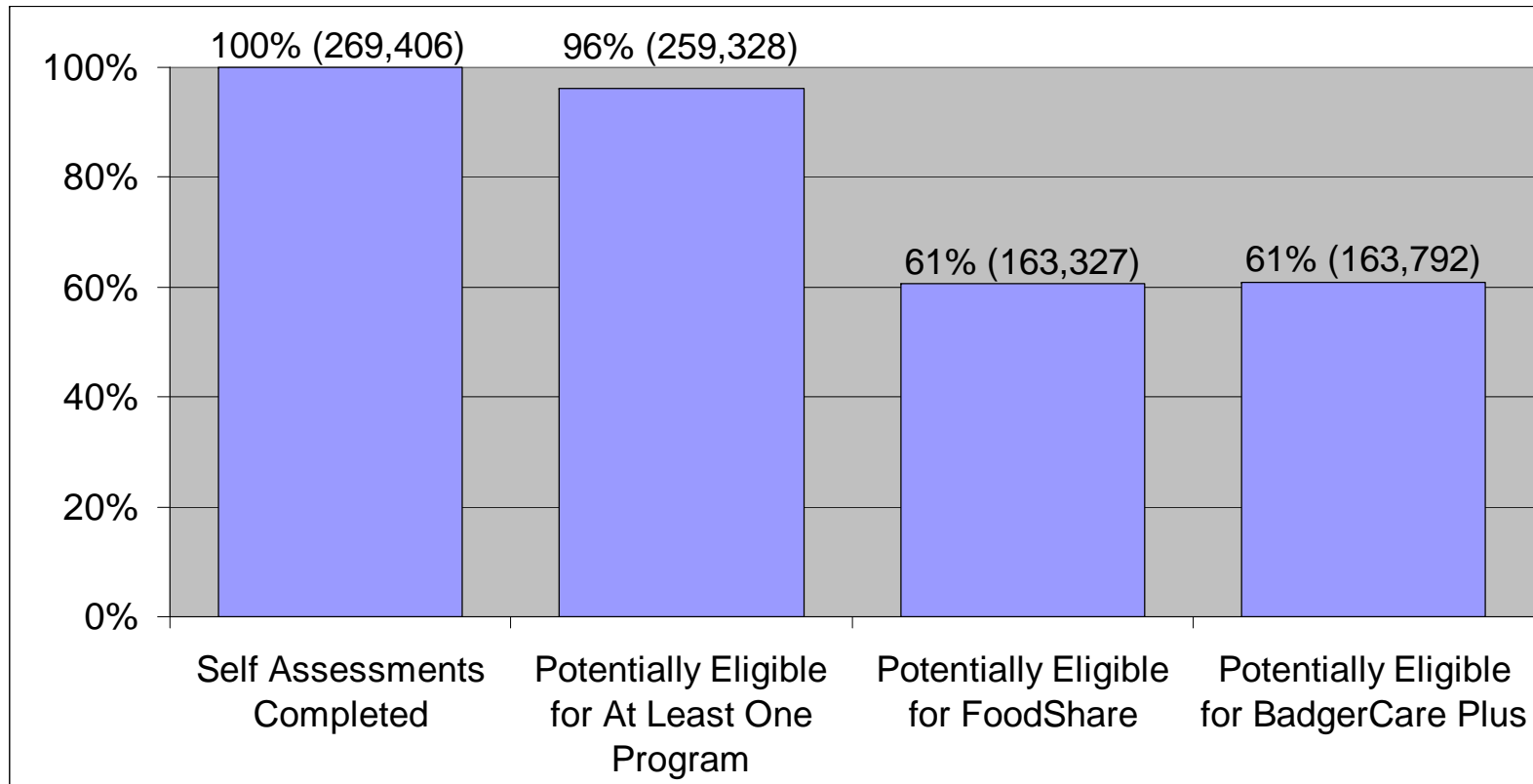
-Beginning in December 2004, totals include the addition of Family Planning Services, Medicaid (EBD), MPA, Long Term Care, SeniorCare, WIC, School Meals/Summer food, TEFAP, and Tax Credits.

-Beginning in late January 2007, totals include the addition of WHEAP (Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program.)

-As of January 2008, Family Medicaid and BadgerCare changed to BadgerCare Plus, Family Planning Waiver changed to Family Planning Services and EBD Medicaid changed to Medicaid.
