

NEED EXTRA CASH?

READ THE FOLLOWING TAX CREDIT/REFUND INFORMATION

◆ WISCONSIN AND FEDERAL EARNED INCOME TAX CREDITS -

You may be eligible for both Wisconsin and Federal tax refunds if you worked for an employer or were self-employed any time in 2006. You may be able to obtain a combined total of state and federal refunds of:

- **Up to \$6,486** for 3 or more children and your family income was less than \$38,348
- **Up to \$5,171** for two children and your family income was less than \$38,348
- **Up to \$2,857** for one child and your family income was less than \$ 34,001

◆ WISCONSIN HOMESTEAD CREDIT -

You may be eligible for up to a maximum tax credit of **\$1,160** if you were a Wisconsin resident for all of 2006 and can provide copies of rent receipts (if renting) or property tax receipts (if you own your home) and your family income was less than \$24,500 for 2006. ◆ FEDERAL CHILD TAX CREDIT -

You may be eligible for up to a maximum federal tax credit of **\$1,000** per dependent child under age 17. This tax credit can be used to lower the amount of federal taxes you owe, but the total credit for all children cannot be more than what you actually owe in federal taxes. ◆ ONE TIME 2006 TELEPHONE TAX REFUND -

You may be eligible for a one time federal refund of **\$30** up to a maximum of **\$60**, depending on the number of people in your family. This tax refund is for any family that paid for long distance telephone (regular phone and/or cell phone) service between February 28, 2003 and August 1, 2006. Even if you are not required to file a tax return, you can still claim this federal tax refund if you are eligible.
