

## **NEED EXTRA CASH? READ THE FOLLOWING TAX CREDIT/REFUND INFORMATION**

### **WISCONSIN AND FEDERAL EARNED INCOME TAX CREDITS**

You may be eligible for both Wisconsin and Federal tax credits if you worked for an employer or were self-employed any time in 2009. You may be able to obtain a combined total of state and federal credits of up to:

- **\$8,090** if you have 3 or more children and your family income was less than \$43,279 (Single), \$48,279 (Married).
- **\$5,732** if you have 2 children and your family income was less than \$40,295 (Single), \$45,295 (Married).
- **\$3,165** if you have 1 child and your family income was less than \$35,463 (Single), \$40,463 (Married).

### **WISCONSIN HOMESTEAD CREDIT**

You may be eligible for up to a maximum tax credit of **\$1,450** if you were a Wisconsin resident for all of 2009 and can provide copies of rent receipts (if renting) or property tax receipt (if you own your home) and your family income was less than \$24,500 for 2009. ### **FEDERAL CHILD TAX CREDIT**

You may be eligible for up to a maximum federal tax credit of **\$1,000** per dependent child under age 17. This tax credit can be used to lower the amount of federal taxes you owe, but the total credit for all children cannot be more than what you actually owe in federal taxes. ### **CHILD AND DEPENDENT CARE CREDIT**

A family may be able to claim the Child and Dependent Care Credit if the wage earner pays someone to care for a qualifying child dependent that is under age 13 or a spouse or dependent that is not able to care for himself or herself and who lived with the family for more than half of the year. The credit can be up to 35% of allowable care expenses. More detailed information can be found at <http://www.irs.gov/individuals>

Starting **February 1, 2010** you can get **free tax help** by contacting a Wisconsin Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) site. VITA sites can be found in some community centers, libraries, churches, shopping malls, and retirement homes.
