

## **Injury Disparity Programs**

**Evidence-based prevention programming.** The Division of Public Health's Injury Prevention Program is collaborating with DPH chronic disease programs in the Bureau of Community Health Promotion and the Bureau of Aging and Disability Resources in the Division of Long Term Care on a grant funded by the U.S. Administration on Aging to support evidence-based programming. This program supports the expansion of the Chronic Disease Self-Management Program (CDSMP) and "Stepping On," a community-based fall prevention program, to older adults throughout the state.

DHFS staff are working with the developers of CDSMP and Stepping On, the United Community Center in Milwaukee, and the Oneida Nation to assure availability of culturally competent versions of these programs for Latino and American Indian populations.

**Injury-related disparity report.** The Injury Prevention Program is currently working on a report to present findings of research on the existence of disparities of injury occurrence and health outcomes in Wisconsin residents.
