What is “Healthiest Wisconsin 2020”?	Everyone Living Better Longer
What is the purpose of the State Health Plan?	The purpose is integration and alignment of policies and systems to create a strong Public Health System that will foster the plan’s overarching goals.
Goals	(1) Improve health across lifespan and (2) Achieve health equity
Critical Success Factors	<p>The State Health Plan is a policy plan that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Is a shared plan between Public Health System partners ▪ Is endorsed by our partners ▪ Is measurable ▪ Is implementable ▪ Articulates with existing strategies, programs, and plans at the State and National levels ▪ Promotes alignment with partners <i>Partners are able to see themselves in the plan and use the plan to influence decisions and guide actions</i> ▪ Clearly shows relationships and integration among focus areas
Plan Components	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Objectives, Goals, and Metrics ▪ Communications & Marketing ▪ Accountability
Intended Audience	Public Health System Partners (refer to outer ring of model): Government, Public, Private, Nonprofit, Voluntary
Intended Use of the Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Influence public health policy ▪ Provide direction to assure sustainable public health resource allocations ▪ Provide guidance to protect the health and safety of the 5.5 million people of Wisconsin
What the SHP is	A plan that provides policy direction for the future and creates a system of alignment with partners
What the SHP is not	The State Health Plan is <i>not</i> a plan for the individual
What the SHP looks like	<p>Consists of multiple documents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ State Health Plan document <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Light, crisp, short ♦ Contains the essence of the plan; not all of the details ▪ Multiple Appendices to the Plan <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Supporting details (e.g. definitions, detailed explanation of the model and methods used to develop the plan, evidence, etc.) ▪ Focus Area Details ▪ Goals ▪ Communications & Marketing ▪ Accountability ▪ Implementation Plan (companion document or appendix?)
