Source: Wisconsin Blood Lead Testing Data, WIC Enrollment Files, Medicaid Eligibility Files (all data current as of April, 2003)

Test: Number of unduplicated children with a capillary or venous blood lead test. If a child has a venous test within three months after a capillary test, the data from the venous test are included in this report.

Poisoned: A capillary or venous BLL ≥ 10 mcg/dL. If the test is a capillary sample followed within 3 months by a venous test, the value of the venous test is used.

Case: One venous BLL ≥ 20 mcg/dL or 2 venous BLLs > 15 mcg/dL drawn at least 90 days apart; includes both new cases and those identified in a previous calendar year.

Prevalence: Number of poisoned children divided by the number of children tested; indicates the total identified burden of lead poisoning in a community.
