

Support Group Attendance for July 2010 Implementation.

Two new fields will be required in July 2010 for tracking the support group attendance of a member before starting a service and ending a service. The Family Relationship fields <family_relationship> and <close_status_f> will no longer be required but can be sent after this implementation (July postings). The new field requirements are as follows:

Name: <support_group_attend_at_admin> <close_status_support_group>

Valid values and descriptions for both fields are:

- 1 – attended 16 or more times in the past 30 days
- 2 - attended 8 to 15 or more times in the past 30 days
- 3 - attended 4 to 7 or more times in the past 30 days
- 4 - attended 1 to 3 or more times in the past 30 days
- 5 – no attendance in the past 30 days

Specifics:

1 digit numeric field

<support_group_attend_at_admin> is required on all records for each new service strip started after June 30, 2010. Values should remain constant throughout the member's continual service. If the member ends services and then returns a different value may be entered.

A new service strip is defined as a service not currently being received by the provider rendering the service for the same target group value. The service strip consists of SPC code and subprogram code + Target Group + Provider Number. If any of these values change it is considered a new service strip. If the member is receiving service 705.10 by provider 1 earlier than July 1, 2010 and then changes providers then this would be considered a new service strip and the new provider should ask the question about support group attendance and submit the value via the way you collect data from that provider. Each service strip could have a different value but each individual service strip should remain constant for this value since it is at the start of the service.

<close_status_support_group> is a closing status and is required when the SPC end reason is 1-3, but can be given with other end reasons. When one closing status is given they must all be given.
