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1. Does the cost of the mentor need to be included in the budget submitted with the proposal?

No. The cost for the mentor and a Pathways consultant assigned to each CRP grantee is covered separate from the grants made to participating CRPs.

2. Can a CRP interested in submitting a proposal in response to this RFP come to DHS to review the proposals and scoring results from the 2009 CRP Rebalancing RFP process?

Per the RFP for the 2009 CRP Rebalancing Initiative, the period of time for reviewing these proposals ended April 14, 2009. At this time however, you could come to the Department and view the ten proposals that were funded and the total points awarded to each of these proposals.
