

## IV Drug Grant RFP Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can you submit two proposals – one for prevention and one for treatment?

A: Yes. If you wish to apply for both services you would need to submit two separate proposals.

Q: If you have offices in several counties, can you apply for a grant in each county?

A: Yes, you can apply in each county; however, you can also form a consortium with the counties involved.

Q: Is the 2 million total amount of money earmarked for IV Drug services the same as last year?

A: Yes, the amount is the same.

Q: Are the forms needed to complete the application available as fillable forms online?

A: At this time they are not available online.

Q: How can we find out about changes to the RFP process?

A: Any changes will be posted on the following website: [www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/rfp/](http://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/rfp/)  
As well, anyone that sends a letter of intent to apply will be put on an email distribution list and will be notified when any changes occur.

Q: Is there a template for the letter of intent?

A: No. Please use your own letter head when writing your intent to apply letter.

Q: Is it recognized that prevention services focus on communicable diseases such as Hepatitis C?

A: Yes. In section 1.3 Program Goals of the RFP, it indicates that the prevention or reduction of complications associated with IV Drug use is a primary goal of prevention services offered.
