

WAPC Neonatal Nutritional Discharge Plan

The Neonatal Nutrition Discharge Plan was developed by the Nutrition Committee of Wisconsin Association for Perinatal Care (WAPC) to assist in the transition from the hospital to the community for infants in the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) with special nutritional needs. It is meant to be completed by the discharge coordinating nurse, dietitian, or other appropriate health care professional. This form will assist the WIC Nutritionist in supporting the medical prescribed nutrition care plan of the infant client and if appropriate the breastfeeding mother. If you have a WIC mother with an infant in a NICU, request staff to use this means to communicate infant's discharge plan and feeding status.
