Notes

1. Reporting period is January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006; analyses based on one record per child; excludes records with unknown data or errors. 100% of data comes from the Wisconsin WIC Program.
2. At risk of overweight and overweight is based on 2000 CDC growth chart percentiles for length-for-age for children under 2 years of age and height-for-age for children 2 years of age and older. At risk of overweight is the 85th - < 95th percentile BMI for age; overweight is \geq 95th BMI for age.
3. Infants born during the reporting period included in the analysis; low birthweight is < 2500 grams; high birthweight is > 4000 grams.
4. Infants born during the reporting period included in the Ever Breastfed analysis. Infants who turned 6 months of age during the reporting period by/on their date of visit included in the Breastfed At Least 6 Months analysis. Children who turned 12 months of age during the reporting period by/on their date of visit included in the Breastfed At Least 12 Months analysis.
5. Children ages 2 years and older included in the analyses.
6. Based on the 1998 CDC MMWR, "Recommendations to Prevent and Control Iron Deficiency in the United States", altitude adjusted, children 6 months and older included in the analysis.

* Percentages are not calculated if <100 records are available for analysis after exclusions.
