Topic: IRIS Budget Calculations for Individuals Re-enrolling in IRIS

Purpose

This bulletin is intended to provide guidance to ADRCs regarding IRIS budget calculations when an individual is interested in re-enrolling in IRIS.

Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRCs) have the responsibility to provide enrollment counseling to eligible individuals interested in enrolling in a long term care program. Part of this enrollment counseling includes accessing the IRIS budget calculation via the Long Term Care Functional Screen (LTC FS).

For individuals that were enrolled in IRIS, have subsequently dis-enrolled and are now interested in re-enrolling in IRIS, the ADRC will not be able to view the IRIS budget calculation via the LTC FS. Instead, the ADRC will receive a notice on the LTC FS that the IRIS budget is available to the individual if they contact their IRIS Consultant or the IRIS Consultant Agency. In these cases, the ADRC should refer the individual to the IRIS Consultant Agency (ICA) for more specific information regarding their IRIS budget calculation.
