


Building a Medical Home

Project Aim:

Identify all necessary operational, financial and regulatory infrastructures for the effective co-location of mental health and primary care between BBHS and PHS.

Strategies:

1. Optimize clinical data sharing between BBHS and PHS
2. Optimize utilization of available Mental Health and FQHC reimbursement codes
3. Optimize access, utilization and compliance of primary care services by BBHS clients with serious co-morbid conditions.

3. Adequate financial and human resources for the completion of the business plan
