Naloxone

Find naloxone near you!	Use the DHS interactive map at www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/opioids/safer-use.htm to find a nearby naloxone provider.
Check if your local health or Tribal health department is a Naloxone Direct recipient.	Naloxone Direct is a program offered by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) that provides naloxone to local or Tribal health departments and community organizations to give out to their community for free.
Ask your local pharmacist.	Many pharmacies provide over-the-counter naloxone at cost or at a lower cost without needing a prescription from a doctor.
Get naloxone mailed to you.	Through Next Distro, Bad River Harm Reduction supplies Wisconsin residents with free naloxone via mail. https://nextdistro.org/widistro
