

Suggestions for Using
Parents Who Host Lose the Most:
Don't Be a Party to Teenage Drinking
Power Point Presentation



- When all the slides are shown and text read, this presentation takes approximately 20-30 minutes.
- A script is included (with citations) under the “Notes” view of the presentation.
- You’ll have a better idea of how the presentation flows if you print out a “Notes” view showing the proposed text for each slide. Read it aloud before speaking to an audience.
- Feel free to paraphrase or modify the text so that it sounds like you.
- You may notice some duplication in the text. That allows you to drop some slides to meet time limits if needed.
- Slides 16 and 17 are a single block focused on alcohol age compliance checks. If Law Enforcement is present, ask them in advance to discuss alcohol age compliance check plans in your community during this part of the program using these slides or others.
- Slides 21 and 22 discuss universal steps to prevent underage drinking.
- Slides 24 through 27 provide a closing block that should be modified to reflect the community’s goals, plans and contact information for those organizing the campaign in the area. If you do not wish to provide contact information, consider providing nonemergency contact information for the police or deleting that slide.
