Copays for BadgerCare Plus and Medicaid Services Will Temporarily Stop

Do you normally pay \$1-\$3 at the pharmacy or for health care visits? This payment is called a **copay**.

We will be making some changes to the copay system from January 1, 2020, to June 30, 2020. During that time, you will not have to pay copays for any health care services or prescriptions.

Bring this Update to the pharmacy, your clinic, or the hospital

Your health care providers may not collect any copays from you for services from January 1, 2020, to June 30, 2020. Bring this Update to your doctor's office and pharmacy to confirm you do not have to pay copays during this time.



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What's Happening?

No copays from January 1–June 30, 2020

Call to Action

Keep this Update and bring it to your pharmacy and doctor where you may be charged a copay

Any services you get before January 1, 2020, may still have copays. For example, if you refill your pharmacy prescriptions before January 1, 2020, but pick it up after January 1, you may still have a copay.

Some clinics never collect copays from Medicaid and BadgerCare Plus members. If that is the case for you, this change will not affect you.

Definition

A copay is a payment you make at the time of a health care visit or at the pharmacy.
