## CONFLICTS BETWEEN IN-PATIENTS

## THE LAW

Each patient shall... "Have a right to a **humane psychological and physical environment** within the hospital facilities..."

§ 51.61(1)(m), Wis. Stats. [Emphasis added.]

[NOTE: See also entries under **Safety** in this digest, for cases where patients threatened the safety of their peers.]

## DECISIONS

1. A patient complained about harassment and threats from a peer. The facility promptly removed the instigator of the conflicts and, in so doing, protected the remaining clients. This made the complaint moot since there was no further remedy available. (Level III decision in Case No. Case No. 11-SGE-07 on 06/22/12)
