Field Additions to the LTCare Encounter Datamart

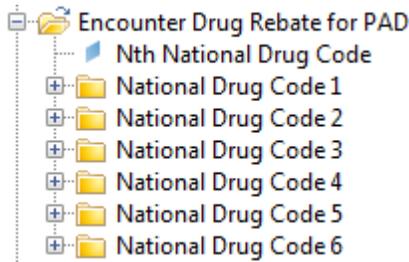
Purpose/Background

The following fields, and associated attributes, have been added the LTCare Encounter Datamart:

- National Drug Codes (NDCs) for Physician Administered Drugs
- Billing and Rendering Taxonomy and Specialty Codes
- New filters for NDCs

National Drug Codes for Physician Administer Drugs

Location: Encounter Detail >> Encounter Drug Rebate for PAD



A National Drug Code is comprised of a 5 byte numeric labeler code, 4 byte numeric product code and a 2 byte numeric package code. It's used to uniquely identify a drug, its labeler & package size of a product for pricing and service/prior authorization.

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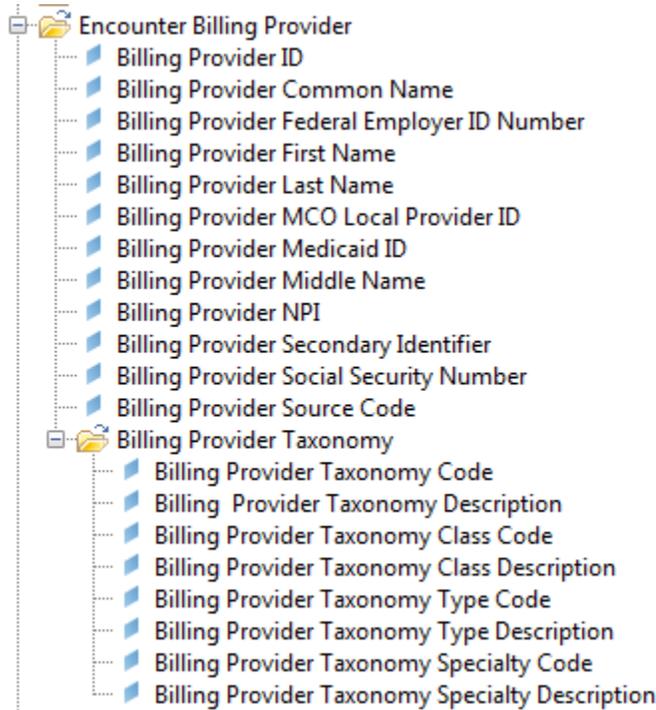

The Provider Taxonomy Code Set is a hierarchical code set that consists of codes, descriptions, and definitions. Provider Taxonomy Codes are designed to categorize the type, classification, and/or specialization of health care providers.

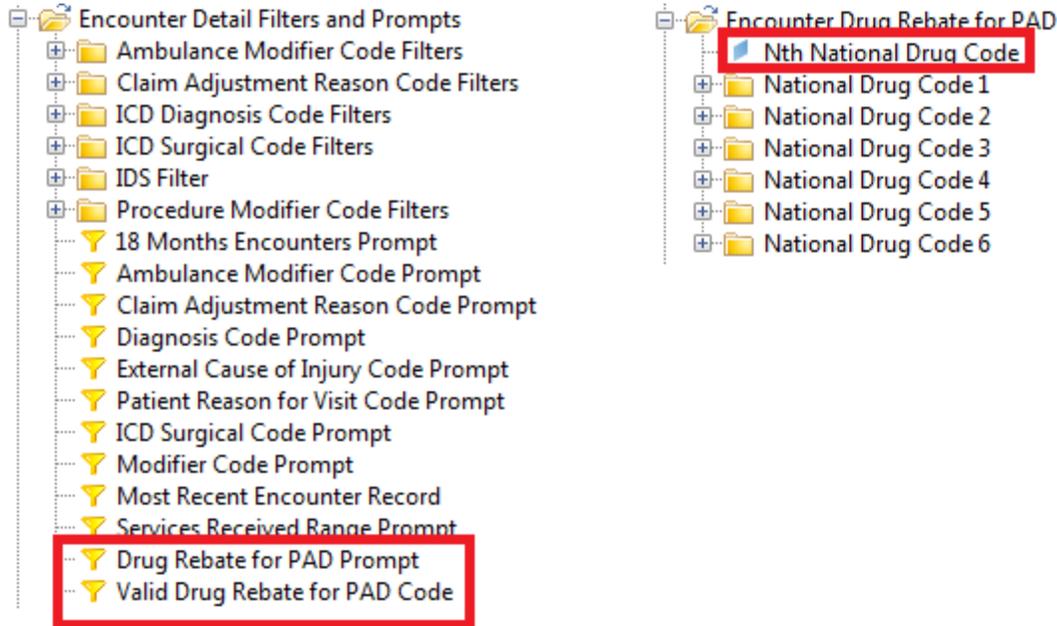
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New filters for NDCs

Location: Encounter Detail >> Encounter Detail Filters and Prompts and
Encounter Detail >> Encounter Drug Rebate for PAD



Drug Rebate for Prompt:

Allows end user to filter by NDC columns and match on a specific, user-defined value. Records with no NDC code will have a value of??-VNR (value not reported).

Valid Drug Rebate for PAD Code:

Allows end user to filter for any records with a valid NDC code.

Nth National Drug Code:

Allows end user to filter for a NDC code in a specific position (1-6). This can be used as an object or as a filter, e.g. query for records whose third NDC code has a value of 9999. If a value outside of 1-6 is entered, it will be treated as??-VNR.

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
