I Respect I Self Direct (IRIS) Encounter Data

I Respect I Self Direct (IRIS) program encounter data now exists in the LTCare Data Warehouse. The data can be found in the LTCare Encounter Data Mart. You must request the IRIS program data in order to access the IRIS data in the data mart.

You may have seen IRIS data in the past in the LTCare Encounter Data Mart, but can no longer see the IRIS data. This was caused by the encounter application incorrectly coding IRIS data with a Family Care program code. The encounter application team has corrected the program code on IRIS encounters and the data warehouse has been updated to reflect the newly corrected data. Family Care program data users were seeing a limited amount of IRIS program data in the past, because of this coding issue.

If you need to continue to have access to the IRIS encounter data, simply send in an access request form to add the IRIS program data to your permissions.

NOTE: This only affects internal state users. External users did not have access to the IRIS data.
