Adult Functional Screen Behavioral Information Supplement and Mental Health Behaviors additions

Purpose/Background

Several new objects have been added to the Adult Functional Screen Datamart Universe that contain new Behavioral Information Supplement captured in the FSIA process as well as a new objects in Mental Health Behaviors. This document provides information on where these new objects are located in the Universe and how they can be used.

Adult Behavioral Information Supplement

The new **Adult Behavioral Information Supplement** objects are located in two locations:

- Attributes > Adult Behavioral Information Supplement
- Reference > Adult Behavioral Information Supplement Reference

Both sets of data originate from the Behavioral Information Supplement form in the Adult Screen portion of the Functional Screen Information Access application. There are, however, important distinctions regarding each group of objects:

In **Attributes > Adult Behavioral Information Supplement** the objects are flags (Y/N) that only indicate if the specific symptom or behavior was selected, regardless of frequency or severity. These flags can be used in combination with any other screen objects or filters.

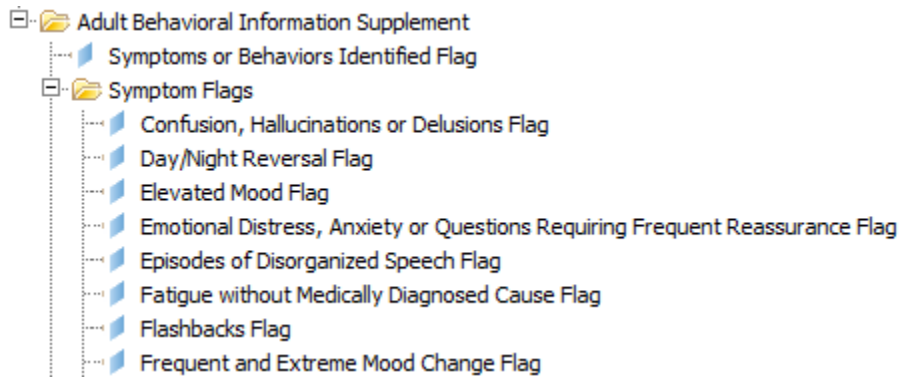

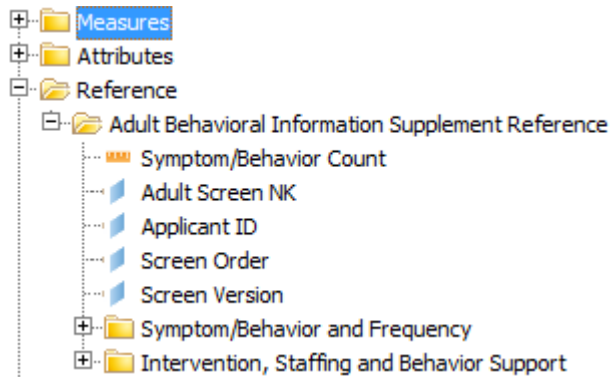
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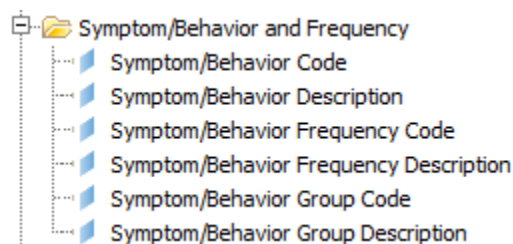
Within each section:



- In **Reference**, the objects contain the values and descriptions that were selected in the FSIA application:



Symptom/Behavior and Frequency:



One important note: The Behavioral Information Supplement objects in the **Reference** class CANNOT be combined in a query with objects from the Attributes class. Reference class objects stand alone.

Objects in Attributes > Adult Behavioral Information Supplement CAN BE combined with other objects in that group such Adult Screener Information, Adult Screen Information etc.

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Adult Mental Health Behaviors



Two new fields have also been added to the Adult Behavior Substance Abuse folder, a **Substance Abuse Code** and a **Substance Abuse Description**. Previously three selectable flags were present and are now depreciated. The old fields and values prior to August 22, 2014 are still available but will not contain a value for any screens performed after that date as those options were no longer present. Similarly the new Substance Abuse Code and Description are not populated prior to the implementation date.

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
