

## Release Notes 1.6.0.0

### 2011 Rate Target Group/Description

A modification was made to the adult functional screen data mart in the LTCare Data Warehouse. In this release, two new universe objects have been added to reflect a change in the rate target group calculation for the year 2011. Using these two new objects in queries will result in a target group based on the 2011 rate target group calculation. Using these objects will provide the 2011 target group regardless if the screen was actually done in 2011.

The new names for the objects are:

- 2011 Rate Target Group
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description

The new objects are located in the sub-class folder named “Adult Hierarchical Target Group” which is located within the class folder named “Adult Target Group”.

The logic for each of the new objects is as follows:

If Developmental Disability Code = "001" or "002" THEN

- 2011 Rate Target Group Code = DD
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description = Developmental Disability

Otherwise

If Physical Disability Flag = "Y" THEN

- 2011 Rate Target Group Code = PD
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description = Physical Disability

Otherwise

If Frail Elderly Flag = "Y" THEN

- 2011 Rate Target Group Code = FE
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description = Frail Elder

Otherwise

If Death in One Year Flag = "Y" AND Age at Eligibility Calculation >=65 THEN

- 2011 Rate Target Group Code = FE
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description = Frail Elder

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Otherwise

If Alzheimer Dementia Flag = "Y" AND Age at Eligibility Calculation  $\geq$ 65 THEN

- 2011 Rate Target Group Code = FE
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description = Frail Elder

Otherwise

Everything Else

- 2011 Rate Target Group Code = PD
- 2011 Rate Target Group Description = Physical Disability

In plain language, if a member has a developmental disability, they will be considered developmentally disabled. If a member has a physical disability, but is not considered developmentally disabled, that member would be considered physically disabled. If a member is terminally ill or has Alzheimer's disease, and is 65 or older, that member would be considered frail elderly. If a member is considered neither developmentally disabled nor frail elderly, they would be categorized in the physically disabled population.

Values will be Developmental Disability, Physical Disability, or Frail Elder.

## Previous Rate Target Group/Description

- Rate Target Group
- Rate Target Group Description

The new names for the objects are:

- Previous Rate Target Group
- Previous Rate Target Group Description

The new objects are located in the sub-class folder named "Adult Hierarchical Target Group" which is located within the class folder named "Adult Target Group".

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
