### Grant Opportunity for Coordinated Specialty Care Program

The Division Care and Treatment Services (DCTS) has issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to implement Early Intervention Programs for First Episode Psychosis (FEP) utilizing Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC). This RFP, titled Coordinated Specialty Care for Early Intervention of First Episode Psychosis (RFPG # G-0346 DMHSAS-17), is accessible [online](#).

The CSC evidence-based model is an early intervention program serving youth and young adults aged 15-25 with nonorganic, non-affective psychotic disorder diagnoses. The CSC Program will utilize a coordinated team approach to provide intensive services to young adults in the early stages of FEP utilizing person-centered and recovery-oriented philosophies.

Counties with a program certified under Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 36 for Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) or Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 63 for Community Support Programs are all eligible to apply. In addition, existing Medicaid and Division of Quality Assurance certified CCS programs or Community Support Programs may also apply. Applications are due by 3 p.m. September 23, 2016.
