In planning for the next phase of the State Opioid Response (SOR) grant, a needs assessment, with updated data, was used to determine high-need areas for SOR funding. High-need areas were identified using county-level data in the following areas: county-authorized opioid treatment admissions, opioid-related hospitalizations, opioid-related deaths, diagnosis of opioid use disorder among Medicaid members, and county population. Tribes that fall within these high-need counties are also considered a priority.
