New Winnebago Mental Health Institute Director

This memo is to inform you that effective January 19, 2020, Jessica (Jessie) Andrews will assume the role of director of Winnebago Mental Health Institute (WMHI).

A licensed clinical social worker and school social worker, Andrews has worked in the behavioral health field for nearly 20 years. She currently serves as WMHI's forensic services director. Prior to this role, she worked as a social worker in various capacities for WMHI, the Wisconsin Resource Center, Marquette County, and Madison Metropolitan School District. Her career also includes time as an outpatient mental health clinician with Theda Care Behavioral Health in Menasha, an adjunct instructor for students seeking an associate's degree in alcohol and other drug abuse counseling at Fox Valley Technical College, and a provider of intensive in-home parent training to families facing challenges related to behavioral health through the Neenah-based Family Training Program.

She earned her bachelor's of social work from UW-Oshkosh and master's of social work from UW-Madison.

Andrews will work with WMHI staff and partners to ensure the hospital's programs and services are meeting the needs of patients and the state's public behavioral health system.
