PURPOSE

The purpose of this memo is to announce funding allocations for the FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) Program for 2014.

INTRODUCTION

As part of Wisconsin's 2014-15 biennial budget, Act 20 created Wis. Stat. 49.79 (10), which details eligibility and work requirements for able-bodied adults without dependents (ABAWDs) to be implemented beginning July 1, 2014. The State projects that implementing time-limited benefits and the mandatory work requirement for ABAWDs will substantially increase FSET program participation. To preserve the continuity of all existing services during this time of transition, DHS will maintain contracts with current FSET providers throughout 2014 at the same funding level as contract year 2013, with the exception of contracts for Racine, Kenosha and Walworth counties. These three counties will receive a contract and funding for the time period of January 1, 2014 to June 30, 2014. Department of Health Services (DHS) will preserve contract year (CY) 2013 funding levels for both the 100% Federal Administration allocation and the State and Federal 50/50 allocation.

The federal government is currently operating under Continuing Resolution (CR) and negotiations on government spending are continuing. DHS will notify agencies of any changes that may affect the FSET program as they become available.

Requests to transfer funds among the three (3) expense lines within the state funds matched with federal funds category will be accepted in April and July of 2014.

The attached allocation includes two (2) funding categories: the 100% federal allocation and the state allocation (matched with federal funding). Agency contracts will allocate the appropriations into four (4) administrative categories: 100% Federal Supplemental, FSET Administration-Base, FSET Transportation-Base, and FSET Job Retention-Base. Budget estimates provided to DHS as part of annual FSET plan submission will be used to help allocate

program funds to the appropriate categories. Contracts were not received prior to January 1, 2014. In the interim, local agencies are authorized to start expending program funds for 2014.
