# **Birth to 3 Program Operations Guide**

### **Background**

The Wisconsin Birth to 3 Program is a statewide early intervention program for infants and toddlers under the age of three with developmental delays and disabilities. The program is authorized under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Part C and Wis. Admin. Code ch. DHS 90. The U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) is the federal administering agency. The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) contracts with counties to operate the Wisconsin Birth to 3 Program at the local level.

As indicated in the state/county contract, each local Birth to 3 Program is responsible for operating the Birth to 3 Program in accordance with directives that exists in:

- Federal and state statue and regulations
- Memos and guidance documents issued by OSEP and DHS
- DHS forms and publications
- Technical assistance communications

### **Purpose**

The <u>Birth to 3 Program Operations Guide, P-03138</u>, captures the essential program requirements needed for local Birth to 3 Programs to operationalize the program. This guide is to be used by local Birth to 3 Programs and their subcontracted entities to effectuate local operations.
