Discontinued Requirements for BadgerCare Plus Childless Adults

PURPOSE

This operations memo announces the discontinuation of certain policy requirements for childless adults enrolled in BadgerCare Plus.

BACKGROUND

Effective February 1, 2020, the Department of Health Services (DHS) implemented the following policies for childless adults enrolled in BadgerCare Plus:

- Monthly premiums for members with household income over 50% of the federal poverty level (FPL).
- A treatment needs question as a condition of eligibility.
- An optional BadgerCare Plus Health Survey (health survey) that may reduce the monthly premium.

Based on federal requirements, DHS suspended these policies at the start of the COVID-19 public health emergency in early 2020.

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On November 17, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) revoked Wisconsin's authority to impose monthly premiums and require the treatment needs question as a condition of eligibility for childless adults. These authorities ended December 31, 2023.

POLICY

Effective January 1, 2024, DHS will **discontinue** the following policies for childless adults in BadgerCare Plus:

- Charging monthly premiums for members with household income over 50% of the FPL.
- Requiring that applicants and members answer a treatment needs question.
- Allowing applicants and members to complete an optional health survey.
