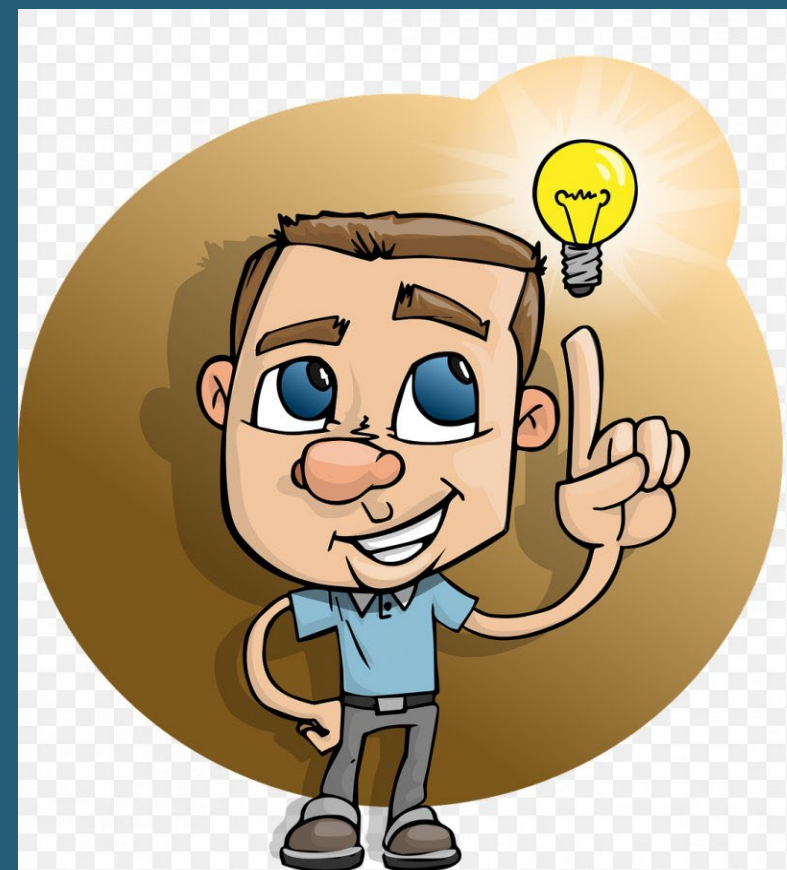

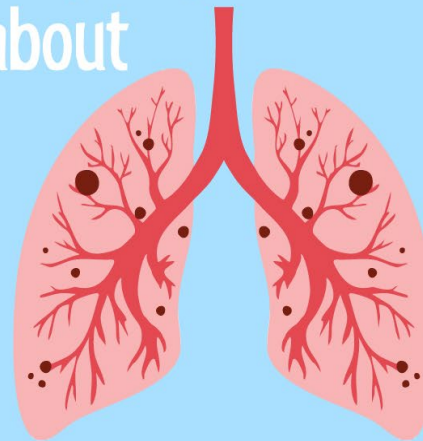

What are the health effects of radon?

Anyone can develop lung cancer from long-term exposure to high radon levels.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
estimates that radon causes about
21,000
lung cancer deaths each year.

Test your home to find out if you should install a radon reduction system.

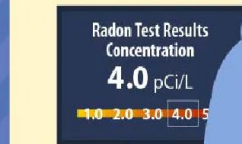

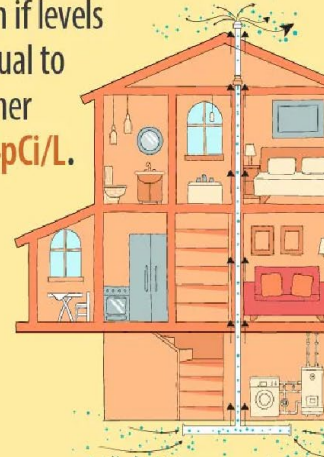

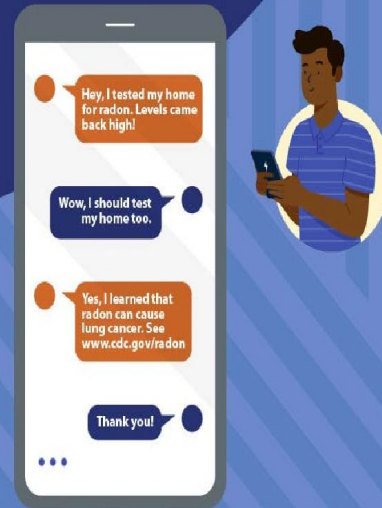
