

What are the health effects of radon?

Anyone can develop lung cancer from long-term exposure to high radon levels.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) estimates that radon causes about **21,000** lung cancer deaths each year.

Where can I be exposed to radon?

Radon can leak into your home from the ground and soil beneath your home, and it is common throughout Wisconsin.


When should I install a radon reduction system?

Test your home to find out if you should install a radon reduction system.

2 steps to protect yourself from radon-associated lung cancer:

Test your home's radon levels.

Install a radon reduction system if levels are equal to or higher than **4pCi/L**.
