## **Service Medical Director Course**

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) Office of Preparedness and Emergency Health Care (OPEHC) is notifying emergency medical service (EMS) medical directors and EMS service directors that a new service medical director training course is now available.

The service medical director course consists of two components. All new service medical directors are required to complete the DHS-developed service medical director training course on Wisconsin-specific content through TRAIN Wisconsin. Additionally, new service medical directors are required to complete the eight-hour National Association of EMS Physicians (NAEMSP) Foundations of Medical Oversight course providing broader medical direction information unless they already meet one of the following criteria:

• EMS fellowship trained from Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education program

Or

• EMS Board Certified or Board Eligible through American Board of Emergency Medicine

Or

• Previously taken 24-hour (NAEMSP) medical director course

New service medical directors must meet these requirements within 180 days from the date of appointment under <u>Wis. Admin. Code DHS §110.49(1)</u>. If you feel you have completed a training equivalent to one of three criteria above, you may submit a request for review to the EMS Section at <u>dhsemssmail@dhs.wisconsin.gov</u>.

Current service medical directors are encouraged, but not required, to meet these requirements.
