Zofran (Ondansetron)

Recently, an EMT-Intermediate service requested that the EMS Physicians Advisory Committee (PAC) consider the use of Zofran (Ondansetron) at the EMT-Intermediate level. After review, PAC recommended to the Department that the use of Zofran be allowed at the EMT-Intermediate level.

Based on the recommendation of PAC, the Emergency Medical Services Section has determined that Zofran will be allowed for use at the EMT-Intermediate level.

Any Intermediate service wanting to use Zofran will need to complete an [Advanced Skills form \(F-00987A\)](#).

The EMS service will need to complete the requirements listed in the form. Once these requirements are met, the EMT-Intermediate service must submit the form and all necessary documentation to the Wisconsin EMS office for final approval. No use of Zofran will be authorized until the EMT-Intermediate service has been provided a letter of approval from the Wisconsin EMS office.
