The certification levels were discussed about the stroke capabilities. The levels are: comprehensive, primary, ready, and not available in the WITrac system. Discussion followed about changing these terms to mirror the trauma levels (1, 2, and 3) so it is self-explanatory. Or have only two options: divert and don't divert. A request was made for the state to do a survey on the services statewide to see who has ambulances with wifi. Waukesha is using this system and will present at the next meeting on their findings.
