Important Update Regarding Your FoodShare Benefits and the FoodShare Benefits Work Requirement

You are getting this letter because you get FoodShare benefits, and you are an adult ages 18 through 49 with no minor children living in your home.

Starting on <month, year>, if you are not able to meet the FoodShare work requirement and do not qualify for any other exemptions, you will be given a temporary exemption from the work requirement. During this temporary exemption you will not lose one of your three months of time-limited FoodShare benefits if you are not able to meet the work requirement.

You will get a letter at a later date telling you when your temporary exemption will expire. **The temporary exemption will last until no later than <month, year>.** When your temporary exemption expires you may need to meet the FoodShare work requirement again. Unless you meet the work requirement or are exempt, you may only get three months of time-limited FoodShare benefits in a 36-month (three-year) period.
