Your FoodShare Work Requirement Time Limits Will Continue to Be Waived Until September 30, 2022

FoodShare members may need to meet a work requirement to keep getting FoodShare benefits. Normally, if a member does not meet the work requirement, and does not have an exemption, they are limited to three months of benefits in a three-year period.

Recently, Wisconsin has been able to waive the time limits connected to the work requirement for its FoodShare members. This statewide waiver will continue until at least September 30, 2022.

You do not need to take any action now regarding your FoodShare benefits to continue getting them. At a later date, if you must meet the time limits of the FoodShare work requirement, we will tell you this.
