

Katie Beckett Medicaid Referral

Instructions

This form is for county waiver agencies to use when referring a child to Katie Beckett Medicaid. The information on this form will only be used to determine eligibility for Katie Beckett Medicaid and establish a case in CARES. Complete this form and the [Katie Beckett Medicaid Release of Information, F-03096 \(PDF\)](#), including the required signature, to set the application filing date for Katie Beckett Medicaid. The application filing date helps determine when the applicant can start getting benefits if it's decided they meet program rules. Email or fax the completed forms to DHSKatieBeckett@dhs.wisconsin.gov or 608-226-5420, using secure methods that protect protected health information (PHI) and personally identifiable information (PII).
