If you get FoodShare, the FSET (FoodShare Employment and Training) program is here to support you.

FSET is a free program for anyone 16 and older who gets FoodShare. You can learn new job skills, get access to education and training, and find a career that interests you.



FSET can help you:

- Identify the types of careers that match your interests and abilities.
- Explore local job offerings.
- Create or update your résumé.
- Develop and practice interview skills.
- Get a high school equivalency diploma or tech school certification.
- Access training for specific jobs, like certified nursing assistant, customer service representative, forklift operations, truck driver (commercial driver's license), and more.
- Pay for things you need for work, like uniforms, transportation, books, or tools.
- Meet the FoodShare work requirement, if that applies to you.
