This is a new initiative.

Context

The Ashland County Health Department will increase the number of children participating in the fluoride supplement program per the objective of that contract. Approximately 40% of Ashland County children reside in homes without an optimally fluoridated water supply. In order to provide the fluoride supplement program, the private wells of those residents will need to be assessed for naturally-occurring fluoride. As this outreach will extend beyond the WIC program and the MCH program (those populations qualifying for WI State Laboratory of Hygiene fee-exempt well testing), the LHD will need to supplement the cost of well-testing. Ashland County is among the five poorest counties in WI, with a median household income of \$36,000; families will need assistance to fund well testing. This supplementation will assist in our efforts to increase the fluoride supplement services. Funding from the Preventive Health grant will assist the LHD to provide well testing and outreach education in printed material to promote the supplement program. The outcome measure to be used will be the number of participants in the supplement program, the number of private wells tested for fluoride, and the number of family medical clinics receiving outreach materials.

The following early childhood oral health preventive services are considered best practice: 1) anticipatory guidance for parents and other caregivers, 2) an oral health risk assessment for infants and children ages 6 months through 6 years, 3) up to 4 fluoride applications (based on risk determination), and 4) referral (see next page) if necessary.

Baseline for Measurement

This is an ongoing, but revived initiative, as Ashland County has a CDR Team that has been inactive for several years.

Context

The Ashland County Health & Human Services has historically used a Child Death Review Team to investigate child deaths and accidents, and form strategies to prevent death and injuries. This is an evidence-based strategy. Due to a high turnover in trained staff, that team has been inactive for a number of years. Due to an unusual number of child deaths most recently, the team is being revived to again bring stakeholders together to prevent injury and death. New core team members will need training to facilitate CDR team meetings. Likewise, resources are needed to bring stakeholders together and produce decided-upon prevention techniques such as educational material, public speakers, video resources, etc. A portion of the county's Preventive Health funding will be used to train core team members, revive the CDR team and assist with the cost of the first three planned meetings, and fund preventive resources as identified in the CDR team meetings. The outcomes will be measured in the number of trainings attended by core members, the number of team meetings held, and the preventive strategies reached by team members to prevent and reduce child injuries and death.
