Baseline for Measurement

We have an evaluation tool for the "Too Good for Drugs" program which can be modified as changes are made.

We have done some work in the past around prescription drug abuse and have some presentations that were put together. I think the big change this year is collaborating with our community partners. Recently law enforcement has started doing presentations about drug abuse in Douglas County which is bringing attention to this issue.

Context

This objective was chosen so work could continue with 3rd graders in Douglas County and we want to offer the curriculum to more schools (children) this year. The curriculum, "Too Good for Drugs" that is being used is evidence-based. Last year we did a pilot at two schools and used an evaluation tool so we could learn about what was successful and what might need to be modified.

This year we would like to do additional work around abuse of prescription medication. Our goal this year is to increase community awareness about drug abuse in our community. Drug abuse is a big problem in our community and we recognize that we need to work with community partners to tackle this issue. We want to team up with our local law enforcement and work collaboratively.
