Baseline for Measurement

Marinette County Health Department will continue to meet the requirements of a Level II Health Department. By the end of the grant funding period, Marinette County Public Health will have 100% of the LHD's policies updated and linked to essential services of public health where appropriate. Currently, 44% of our policies have been reviewed, updated and linked to the essential services of public health in the last 18 months. This objective will be measured by our performance management tracking tool. We will be using PHAB Domain 11 as a evidence based resource in this work.

Context

This objective was chosen since Marinette County Health Department has worked on accreditation readiness for the past 2 years using the infrastructure mini grants. These mini grants have helped us to develop a strategic plan, quality improvement plan, and most recently a performance management plan along with a performance management tracking tool tailored to the needs of our department. We have undertaken a variety of quality improvement projects (new public health worker orientation materials, increasing fluoride varnishing and oral health education with our WIC population, examining processes for lead screening and efficiencies for documentation). During these activities, we have started the process of updating and revising agency policies as a part of our quality improvement work. Marinette County Public Health is due for our 140 Review in 2015 and through that process, we hope to build upon the quality of documentation we use in our public health area along with the evaluation/performance management tracking tools we use to measure our effectiveness.

Baseline for Measurement

Marinette County Public Health Department is the lead agency for the Safe Kids Marinette County Coalition. We have had 2 Safe Kids Coalition meetings thus far this year and have completed our community needs assessment. A log of prevention activities along with agendas, attendance and meeting minutes will be recorded. Strategies for continued partnership development and sustainability are being implemented. 100% of injury prevention education needs recommended by our Child Death Review Team, will be addressed by our Safe Kids Coalition. This will be measured by our performance management tracking tool.

During this grant cycle, our Safe Kids Coalition will meet quarterly. We will conduct 4 meetings in calendar year 2015 and will conduct a survey of our membership to evaluate strengths and areas of growth for our coalition using <http://www.partnertool.net>. This data will be shared with our membership.

Context

This objective was selected due to the continued desire among community partners and this organization to strengthen injury prevention programming in Marinette County. In 2014, our department was successful in establishing a Safe Kids Marinette County Coalition. Safe Kids Marinette County is the northern most coalition of Safe Kids Wisconsin and the only new Safe Kids coalition established in the past 5 years. Safe Kids, as part of their assessment of new coalitions, insures that there is significant interest and infrastructure existing in communities prior to establishing coalitions. Safe Kids Marinette County identified recreational safety, fire safety and motor vehicle safety as our 3 top prevention focus areas. Prevention funding will help to strengthen the evidence based programming of Safe Kids Marinette County in these 3 identified injury prevention areas in addition to allowing flexibility for work on timely injury prevention topics.

Input Activities

Our Safe Kids Coalition will distribute quarterly informational newsletters that provide reliable and trustworthy injury prevention messaging to agencies that have relationships with young families.

Our Safe Kids Coalition will continue to build an infrastructure of injury prevention resources by maintaining two certified child passenger safety technicians in the local health department and supporting two certified child passenger safety technicians located at the fire department. Families that received CPS education at our community fitting stations will report an increase in comfort level and knowledge of proper child restraint usage as evidenced by self reporting surveys.

Our Safe Kids Coalition will maintain 3 members that are Safe Sleep Champions as recognized by the Eunice Kennedy Foundation and will continue to promote safe sleep messaging in the community with young families. Media outreach will be done twice a year on this subject and documented.

This is a new initiative for Marinette County.

Context

In our last Community Health Assessment, alcohol and other drug abuse was identified as one of the top 3 health focus areas in our county. In our CHIPP, we set as a goal to strengthen the relationship between the local health department and the Healthy Youth Coalition of Marinette and Menominee counties by maintaining a LHD presence with this group. HYC is funded through a drug free communities grant. HYC provides AODA awareness/prevention programming in local schools and also does education and policy work on tobacco and e-cigarette use. This partnership, has allowed the LHD to build capacity in this area and also partner with other interested parties on E-Cigarette awareness activities. During 2014, Marinette County Public Health, Delta-Menominee County Health District and HYC partnered to educate local business owners on their ability to prohibit e cigarette usage in their establishments. Business owners were provided signage to notify patrons of their choice to keep indoor air clean. The City of Marinette, with encouragement from HYC members, to pass a resolution in regards to not using tobacco in city parks. Signage encouraging clean air is being posted in City of Marinette Parks. Public Health staff presented education on ecigarettes to City of Marinette elementary students in grades 1-4 during Red Ribbon Week. In addition, Oneida County, a funded tobacco control coalition, is willing to provide technical assistance to Marinette County staff on public health policy activities.
