This is a continuation of a successful initial year of the program. Previously, 508 students participated in the program. Several classes were not included because of time constraints. This year it is hoped that the number of grades involved will be increased and that grades 1 and 2 in Montello elementary school will be included (2 classes).

Context

Objective was chosen because Marquette County ranks in the bottom 10% of counties on several measurements of nutrition related health determinants. 1 out of 3 adults is obese; 1 in 5 children lives in poverty; 43% receive free or reduced school lunch. Access to fresh foods was a repeated community concern on CHA.

Input Activities

CDC strongly encourages Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant funds be used only on evidence based strategies, best practices or promising practices. Describe the strategies/practices to be used and identify the associated web links as available.

Taste testing fruits and vegetables from "What works for Health" website. We plan to use the funding to increase the knowledge of fresh fruits and vegetables by introducing a new fresh fruit or vegetable to approximately 750 elementary school aged children. By encouraging youth to taste fruits and vegetables, their requirement for fruit or vegetable can increase. Emphasis will be on

Late in 2014, the Marquette Co. Health Department was privileged to have a public health nurse trained and certified through Safe Kids Worldwide as a car seat technician. Because it has been shown that use of a properly installed car seat can reduce the risk of death by 71 percent and because it has been estimated that 73% of car seats are either not used or installed incorrectly, MCHD will implement a promotion of correct installation and use of car seats through a family safety day event.

Using strategies set forth through CDC and Safe Kids Worldwide, the MCHD will implement a Family Safety Day in the early summer to promote safe and correct installation of car seats, Community partners will also be invited to exhibit and discuss additional strategies for reducing injuries to children.
